Life at Lealholm


Fern Class

Fern Class have been very excited to have two extra friends back in our garden - Bob and Tomato! They have settled back into life at Lealholm wonderfully with lots of cuddles!






Fern Class have been drawing still life, using varied media. We were so impressed with their outcomes! Well done!
