School Meal Prices – September 2025

This year, our meal price has been fixed at £3.00 for parents of children who to pay for their meals. This is despite an increase in cost to the school from North Yorkshire Council Caterers. The charge to school, this year, has risen substantially to £3.53 per meal. In September, this cost to school will rise further to £3.81. The school will continue to absorb some of this cost within its own budget in order to allow as many families as possible the opportunity to have a school lunch each day. However, from September 2025, we will have to raise the amount we charge parents to £3.25 per meal, to allow this to be sustainable for the school's budget. Thank you for vour understanding.
