Expenditure

Equipment - £1,106.21

We have replaced several balls that have been lost, purchased tennis nets, new football nets for KS1 and replaced javelin that have been broken due to wear and tear.

CPD (outside agencies) - £2,600

LC development has delivered PE every Monday and provided us with an after school club. Lewis has delivered football, basketball, dodgeball, multiskills, athletics and rounders.

The children have had opportunities to extend and improve their skills and feel confident in balance, co-ordination, speed, agility and communication through both team games and individual participation.
