

### English

During this term, children will be studying 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane' by Kate DiCamillo. The children will be immersed in a range of different text types this half term including using 'The Arrival' by Shaun Tan as a stimulus to writing a variety of fiction pieces. The children will write a formal report, write a sales pitch and create a poem.

### Maths

This term in maths the year 3 and 4 children will be learning about mass and capacity, money, time, properties of shape and statistics. The year 5 and 6 children will cover statistics, properties of shape, position and direction. The year 6 children will also cover algebra and ratio.

**Religious Education-** The questions we will be focusing on this term are, 'What can we learn from religions about deciding what is right and wrong?' and 'Why is Jesus inspiring to some people?' Considering the traditions and identities of different faiths will also fulfil one of our central oaths at Lealholm- preparing the children for life in multi-cultural Britain.

### French

The units we will be focusing on in French this term are:  
Year 3 and 4- vive le sport  
Year 5 and 6- vive le temps libre.

### Geography

The children will be learning about biomes and vegetation belts and they will be able to identify the six main biomes and understand the differences between them.

### Science

The year 3 and 4 children will be covering the topic of 'plants' and the year 5 and 6 children will be covering 'Living things and their habitats.' Children will be developing their working scientifically skills, throughout this term and they will also be consolidating their work on forces.

### Design and Technology

In DT, children will further develop their understanding of mechanical systems. Children will learn about controlling movement with a cam mechanism to create part of an 'Automata Animals'.

### Art

The children will be studying the work of Picasso and creating their own abstract painting based on Picasso.

### History

Children will be learning about the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain by exploring artefacts and carrying out research about their invasion on our coastline. They will produce a timeline and a power point presentation of annotated pictures, of artefacts with notes, to infer aspects of life at this time.

### Computing

Children will be continuing their work on 'Everyone can create drawing.' and 'Everyone can create music' following the Apple Curriculum.

### Music

We will be having a workshop this term to learn how to use the samba drums and then compete follow up work in school.


**Spellings-** Spellings will be given out on a Friday and children will be tested on a Friday (these will be weekly test).
