

English

During this term, children will be studying 'Darwin's Dragons' by Lindsay Galvin. The children will be immersed in a range of different genres this term and will write for a variety of forms including, a myth and legend using a clip as a stimulus, a biography about Alfred the Great, a cinquain poem, a piece of classic fiction and a narrative poem.

Maths

This term in maths the year 3 and 4 children will be covering: multiplication and division, length and perimeter and fractions. In addition, year 3 will cover mass and capacity and year 4 will cover decimals.

The year 5 children will be covering: fractions, decimals and percentages, perimeter and area and statistics. The year 6 children will be covering: ratio, algebra, decimals, area, perimeter, volume and statistics.

Religious Education- The question we will be focusing on this term is, 'What it means to be a Hindu in Britain today? Considering the traditions and identities of this faith will also fulfil one of our central oaths at Lealholm- preparing the children for life in multi-cultural Britain.

Geography

This term, the children will be covering the topic, 'Let's visit North America'. They will be annotating maps of North America and from their learning in this unit, will then be making comparisons between North Yorkshire and North America.

Science

The year 3 and 4 children will be covering the topic of Sound and the year 5 and 6 children will be covering 'Evolution and Inheritance' They will also be developing their working scientifically skills by planning and carrying out different investigations.

FrenchThe year 3 and 4 children will be learning about Vive la sport (sport) and the year 5 and 6 children will be learning about A la plage! (the seaside).

Art

In Art, the children will be exploring the work of Banksy, experimenting with printing and collage to create a piece of artwork in his style.

In DT, the children will be making their own hand puppets by comparing different designs, selecting the tools they need to make it and creating their own.

History

Children will be learning about the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor. They will be exploring this and answering two enquiry questions: *Is it fair to describe the Vikings as vicious raiders and how did the Anglo Saxons regain control of England?*

Computing

Children will use 'Everyone can Create Drawing'- year 3 and 4 children will be creating their own landscapes ,while year 5 and 6 create their own logos. They will continue to Code and they will continue to develop their knowledge of keeping safe online.
